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Research Software in Brazil


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In 2014, some of the finding from the "UK research software survey 2014" by Hettrick et al. were that "92% of academics use research software, 69% say that their research would not be practical without it and 56% develop their own software (worryingly, 21% of those have no training in software development)."










Research Software Dependency

As the first investigation in this area involving Brazil, were find that 93% of Brazilian academics use research software, almost half of Brazilian scientific production would not be practical without the research software used today and half of Brazilian academics develop their own software—worryingly, a quarter of Brazilian researchers are doing their job without training in software development.
